Over the past year, there has been a tremendous atmosphere at the club, as the members, ranging in age from 7-81, have enjoyed playing table tennis.

The 20 or so young people have shown a keen willingness to learn. With the help of grants it has been possible to pay for an advanced level coach to work closely with the voluntary resident club coach. The results have been extremely encouraging as the standard of play has steadily improved, culminating in July this year with 7 of the young people, aged 8 – 14, attending the South East England Regional Trials at the K2 Centre, Burgess Hill. Following the trials, 2 of the young people, Roddy McGillivray (aged 8) and Luke Stewart (11) were selected to join the 'B' Squad.

Two other boys, although they were not selected to play for the squad, have improved remarkably during the past year and deserve particular praise for their dedication and effort. They are Robbie Winters and Kai Mason (both 14). Had they started playing at a younger age it is very likely that they too would be in the squad. However, given their determination to improve they may have an opportunity to make the squad in later years.
